Most of SKEMA's students live in either Antibes or Juan les Pins, adjacent cities close to Sophia and easily accessible by bus.

Food	Meals are provided at the school cafeteria for 2.90€ from Monday to Friday.	
Airport/Bus Transport	Most of the students fly into the NICE Côte d'Azur Airport, which is 45 minutes from Sophia Antipolis campus. There is a bus that costs 1€ run by the General Council of the PACA region. We also have a Pick up Service available at the beginning of each semester. All the main locations around the campus are accessible by bus. There are two kinds of subscriptions: A monthly subscription (12€) or a yearly subscription (100€)	
Health Insurance	The annual mandatory cost to subscribe to the Social Security is 200€ per year for a single non European student planning to stay more than three months.	
Computer facilities	There are computer labs and wireless networks scattered around the Sophia Antipolis Campus, such as the library and the common facilities.

Application Deadlines	Fall Semester 2010 (Sept. to Dec.) : <b>15 May 2010</b> / Spring Semester 2011 (Jan. to Apr.) : <b>15 October 2010</b>
Orientation Day	It is strongly recommended for exchange students to be present on the Orientation Day which is organized the week before the first day of class (early September and January each year). During this day, they usually get all the academic and practical information they need for their integration into SKEMA Business School ==> confirmation of course choices, study schedule, student card, computer account, visit of the campus, residence card info, student associations presentation, and so on.

Residence Permit	For non-European students coming to SKEMA Business School Sophia Antipolis Campus for more than 3 months, and having a long-stay student visa : it is mandatory to apply for a Residence Permit. The International Office proposes assistance every Monday from September to January to help students apply for the residence permit.
