

Global Luxury Management North Carolina State University - SKEMA Business School Dual Degree Program

Calendar Overview

This dual degree program is taught in English at North Carolina State University in Raleigh, NC for the Fall semester (August to December) and at the SKEMA Paris campus for the Spring semester (January to April).

Please note that the Fall 2017 semester at NCSU for GLM students begins **at the beginning of August**. All students are required to be present for the first day of Orientation.

Admission Requirements:

Due to a limited number of places available in this program, a selection will take place.

- First Selection Criteria = Overall GPA
- Second Selection Criteria = Previous experience in the industry and motivation:
 - CV in English with references that could certify this previous experience is required
 - Motivation Letter in English is required
- Required English Proficiency

Required English Proficiency:

In order to be admitted into this program, all non-US citizen applicants must demonstrate proficiency in English at a level necessary to be successful in a graduate program at NC State. **Students must meet this requirement no later than May 30, 2017.**

This requirement can be met in one of the following ways:

1. Provide valid **IBT TOEFL** with an overall score of **at least 80** and minimum test scores for each section:

Listening	18 points
Reading	18 points
Writing	18 points
Speaking	18 points

TOEFL must be **no older than two years** (24 months) prior to the beginning of the requested entry term. **Student must request that the TOEFL IBT score be sent directly to NCSU by ETS (school code: 5496)**

2. Provide valid **IELTS** score with an overall score of **at least 6.5** and minimum test scores for each section:

Listening	6.5
Reading	6.5
Writing	6.5
Speaking	6.5

IELTS must be **no older than two years** (24 months) prior to the beginning of the requested entry term.
Student must request that the IELTS score be sent directly to NCSU

3. Be a citizen of a country where English is the official language **and** the language of instruction in higher education
4. Have successfully completed at least one year of full-time study in a degree program at a four-year US College or university.

Internship:

- In order to obtain the Global Luxury Management degree from NC State University, you must complete an end-of-year internship which is directly related to your field of study (a job or other professional work experience is also accepted).

Visa Information (Raleigh, North Carolina):

- Students who are not legal residents of the United States will be required to request a **J-1 exchange visa** in order to study on the NC State campus
- Details on how to obtain the J-1 exchange visa will be provided by SKEMA's International Office
- Students will need to provide NC State with an official bank statement in order to obtain the DS-2019 (necessary document for the J-1 exchange visa)

Important Notice – Two Year Home Country Physical Presence Requirement:

Certain J-1 exchange visitors are subject to a two-year home-country physical presence requirement which requires you to return to your home country for at least two years at the end of the exchange visitor program. This is also known as the foreign residence requirement under U.S. law, Immigration and Nationality Act, section 212(e).

If you are unable to return to your home country to fulfill the two-year requirement, you must obtain a waiver approved by the Department of Homeland Security prior to changing status in the U.S. or being issued a new visa in certain categories for travel to the U.S.
