## **SKEMA Business School in top 25 worldwide in Financial Times ranking for Master in Management programme, and ranked fifth in France**

**Paris – September, 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018.** The Financial Times has just published its 2018 world ranking for Masters in Management programmes.

SKEMA Business School has been in this ranking since its creation in 2009. This year's 25<sup>th</sup> place, out of 100 international educational institutions, is an improvement of 10 places compared to 2017's ranking.

Our Master in Management ranks fifth among the 25 best French Grandes Ecoles represented.

SKEMA stands out particularly on several criteria:

- International Student Mobility: the school gains a place and ranks 17<sup>th</sup>
- Objectives achieved by graduates thanks to their degree (Aims Achieved): SKEMA moves up 12 places and is ranked 20<sup>th</sup> in the world
- Proportion of female students in comparison to male students: SKEMA ranks 13<sup>th</sup>
- Female Faculty: SKEMA ranks four places higher on this criterion, in 21<sup>st</sup> place

This progress reflects SKEMA's teaching model which is now based on the three new academies into which the school's teaching staff is deployed: innovation, globalisation, digitisation.

Alice Guilhon, managing director of SKEMA and president of the Chapter of Management Schools of the Conference of Grandes Ecoles (CGE) explains: "Combining this new ranking with our fourth place in the FT's latest world ranking on finance training (for the MSc Financial Markets & Investments), we see broad recognition of our teaching model."
